This course will enable the attendee to recognize the purpose of documents submitted in conjunction with a building permit application, conduct reviews of architectural plans and specifications for proposed buildings to properly apply code requirements, and identify compliant and non-compliant building conditions. Through instruction and directed practical exercises, attendees will acquire the knowledge, skills, and techniques to review building plans and specifications, as well as composing effective reports with supporting documentation.

Subjects addressed include site plan reviews for emergency apparatus access; review of architectural drawings for construction requirements, means of egress and fire-resistive compartmentalization; heating, ventilation, and air conditioning; and an assessment of built-in fire protection systems.
