



New England Association of Fire Marshals Membership Application

Membership

Section 1. Membership in the New England Association of Fire Marshals shall be open to:

- a. Federal, State, and Local Fire Marshals and their deputies, the staffs of Fire Prevention Bureaus, Fire Department personnel of all ranks with a primary interest in fire prevention, and officials of state, County, and Municipalities charged with the duty of investigating the cause and origin of fires; and
- b. Individuals who support fully the efforts of the fire service and this Association to bring about a reduction in the loss of human lives and the destruction of property by fire and the suppression of arson.
- c. Applications for membership shall be made by written application on forms provided by the Association and submitted to the Secretary/Treasurer. The Board of Directors shall, at its sole discretion, determine any applicant's qualification for membership. Section 3. Honorary Life Membership may be conferred upon any member in good standing of the Association retiring from office after ten or more years' service as a Federal, State, County, or Municipal Fire Marshal, or as full-time members of the staffs of these officials, or who has rendered out-standing service to the Association
