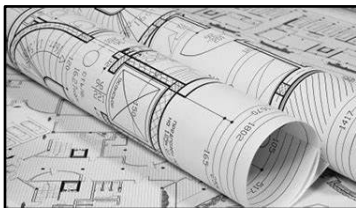
Subjects addressed in the seminar include:
